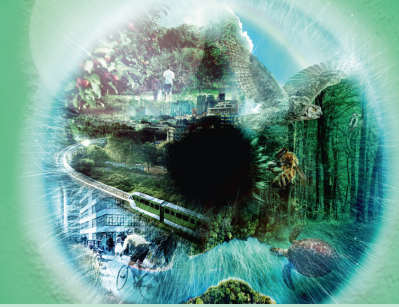

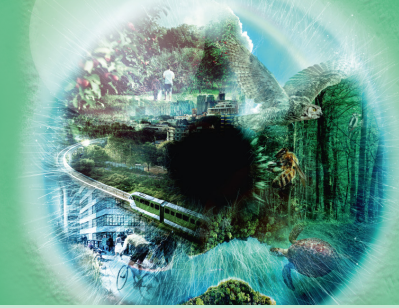

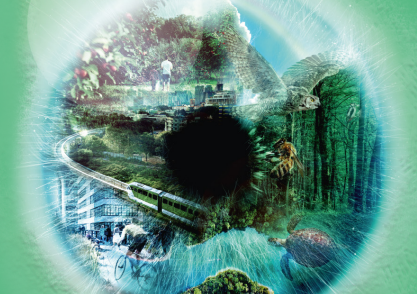

The winning classes were:

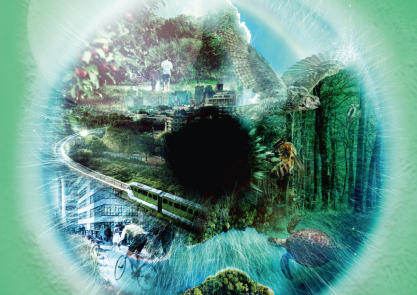
